

BFI NETWORK Midlands coworking membership.

Terms

Members of the BFI NETWORK Midlands coworking space are entitled to free tea and filter coffee and selected meals at discounted prices from the Broadway Cinema café bar during coworking days.

Discounted and complimentary tickets for films and selected events at Broadway are for coworking space members only and are non-transferrable.

You will need to present your lanyard to Broadway's Box Office staff to obtain tickets, tickets will not be issued without your lanyard.

Tickets for selected special events are available at a discounted rate and are subject to availability.

Complimentary tickets are limited to a maximum of *1 ticket per week*.

Membership of the coworking space is by application and for a period of 6 months.

Eligibility

- You are eligible for this scheme if you are a Midlands based filmmaker who has yet to have a feature film theatrically distributed.
- Evidence of previous creative work - You will need to have a [BFI NETWORK Postroom](#) account, showing evidence of your previous creative track record.
- Clarity in articulating how coworking membership will support the development of your project, filmmaking and professional development.
- You must be aged 18 or over and not in full time education.
