BFI NETWORK teams at Film Hub South West, South East and Midlands are once again coming together to run an online networking event for writers, directors and writer-directors based in our regions who are looking for a UK-based producer to collaborate with on a short form narrative project that they intend to submit to the BFI NETWORK Short Film Fund.

The event will run via online platform [Deal Room](#) on *Thursday 12 August 2021 between 9am and 8pm* and enable talent to book private 121s with those whose profiles indicate they might be possible future collaborators.

Who can apply:

Participation in the BFI NETWORK Connect + Collab is free and open to directors and writer-directors from South West, South East or Midlands of England as defined by the BFI ([BFI UK nations and regions map](#)) who are actively working on a short form narrative project that they intend to submit to the BFI NETWORK Short Film Fund. As space is limited, there is a selection process before your attendance is confirmed.

To apply you must be:

- 18 or over
- Not in full-time education
- A current, full-time resident in the South West, South East or Midlands of England as defined by the BFI ([BFI UK nations and regions map](#))
- Able to demonstrate a willingness to collaborate with a UK-based producer
- Actively be working on a narrative short film project (under 15 minutes) that would be eligible for the BFI NETWORK Short Film Fund ([download the guidelines here](#))
- Available to attend the online event on Thursday 12 August 2021 9am-8pm for either the full day or part of the day.
